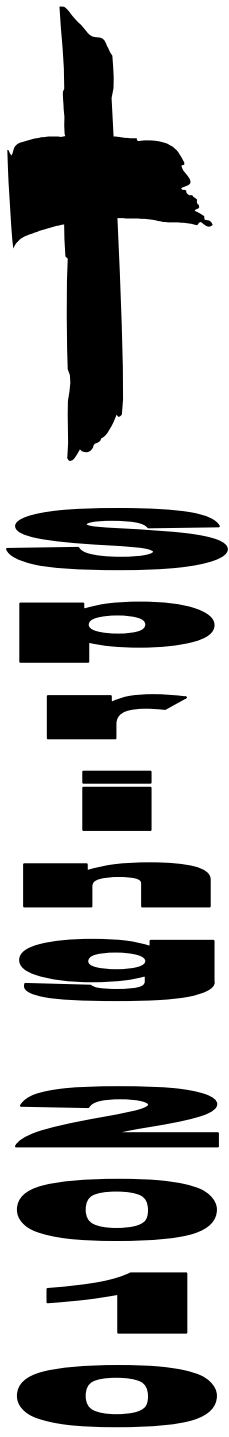

Sharing the Gospel

Spring is here!! With the beginning of this new year comes the anticipation of new beginnings, new with Christ, and the planting new seeds of the Gospel, new flowers, new vegetables and yes new Churches.

Here are a few facts that you may find interesting as we consider the need for GPS(God's Plan for Sharing) and for new churches.

Did you know that....

The unchurched population of the United States is over 200 million?

The United States is the 3rd largest unchurched nation.

North America is the only continent where Christianity is not growing?

There are over 28 million within the BCNY . One in every 11 Americans lives in our state convention territory

There is one SBC church for every 50000 persons in Western New York

There is one Southern Baptist Christian for every 1000 in Western New York.

One the average, Evangelical churches, younger than 3 years old annually win 10 people to Christ per 100 church members. Churches 3-5 years old, win 5 people to Christ per 100 members and older than 15 years old annually win 3 people to Christ per 100 church members.

GPS- God's Plan for Sharing: this past Easter many of our churches took part in GPS and were blessed with Salvations, plus larger than normal attendance on Easter. It is still helping today. Therefore, :”When Jesus saw the multitude...weary and scattered like sheep having no shepherd, He said to His disciples, the harvest is plentiful but the laborers are few...Pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers. Where are the Laborers? Answer: In your local church. You are the laborers of whom Jesus spoke.
